Be it and it is hereby resolved that the Nova Scotia Health Authority Board of Directors hereby approves the delegation of its policy determination authority in accordance with Schedule A attached hereto.

Schedule A -Policy Approval Framework

The Board of Directors of the Nova Scotia Health Authority (NSHA) has overall oversight and authority in relation to policies, procedures, guidelines and protocols (PPGPs) of the NSHA. Where appropriate, the Board delegates to the appropriate Body/Committee (e.g.: Executive Leadership Team (ELT), Zone Medical Executive Directors and Executive Directors (EDs) Health Authority Medical Advisory Committee, etc.) or the appropriate Vice-President, Senior Director, or Department Head as indicated in the table below.

General Principles:

- Initial Approval Body confirms readiness for Final Approval. Policy has no effect until Final Approval.
- Clear and streamlined.
- Decrease the # of required approvals where appropriate. Maximize the stakeholder feedback to get appropriate engagement.
