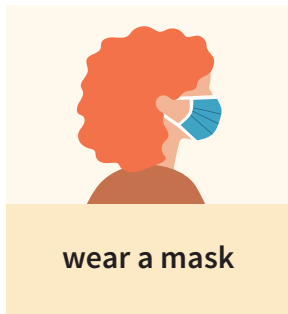




Information about COVID-19 vaccines

Yes. Even after both doses of the COVID-19 vaccine, you must continue to follow public health advice to prevent spread of COVID-19. Continue to follow this advice until we know more about how well the vaccine prevents infection and reduces the risk of passing the virus to others.

Why are vaccinated people still required to follow public health measures? Isn't that the point of a vaccine?

We know the vaccine is very good at preventing symptoms of COVID-19.

However, the vaccine needs to be studied longer to make sure that people who have received it cannot pass the virus on to others without having any symptoms.

Until most Nova Scotians have been vaccinated, all residents and visitors in Nova Scotia will have to follow all public health measures.
